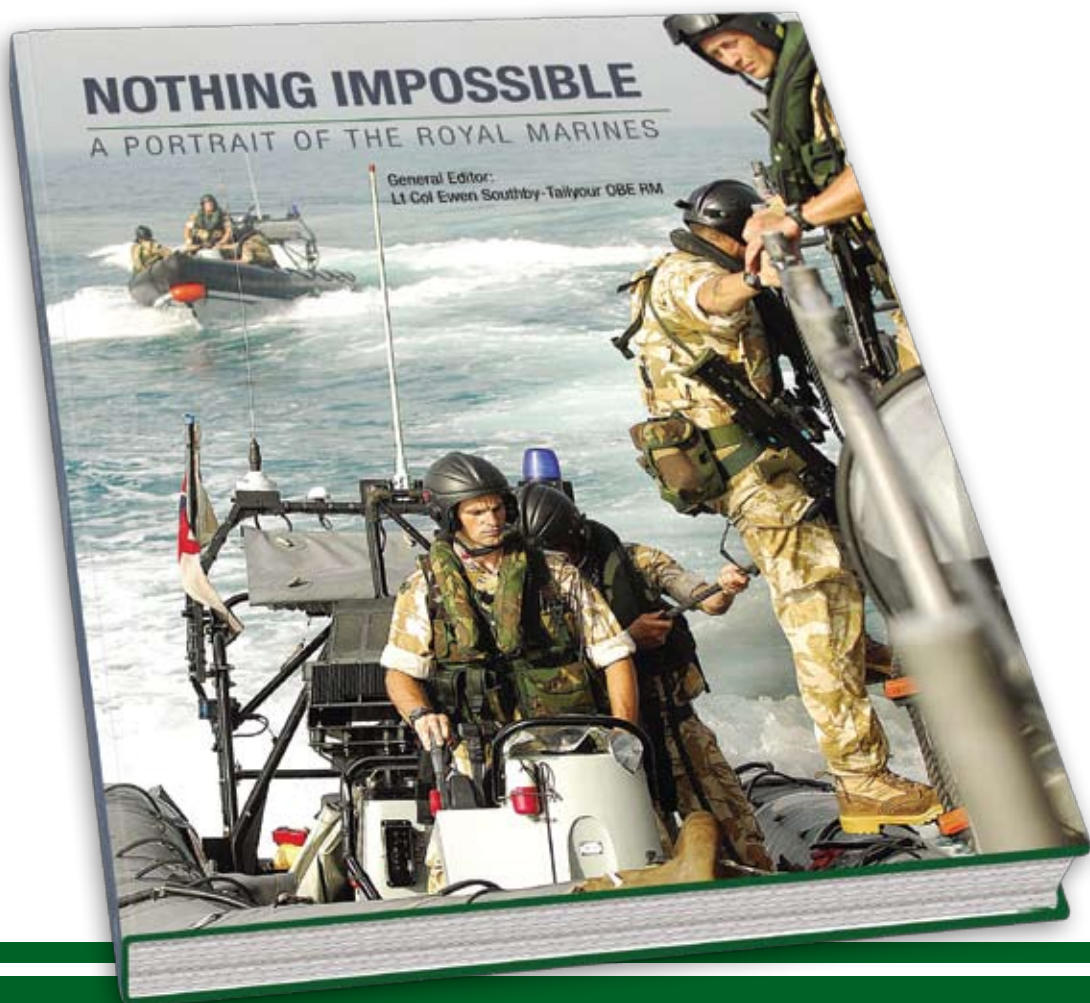


NOTHING IMPOSSIBLE:
